Continuing the Journey to Zero-Waste

Our commitment to waste diversion at our two U.S. compounding plants continued to gain momentum. The Taylorsville plant identified and successfully diverted three additional recyclable waste streams from landfills, working with a local recycler.

New Waste Streams Identified

The team focused on incoming packaging, finding opportunities in:

- Supersacks
- Additive packaging
- Stretch wrap

These packaging materials alone contributed to diverting of over 15,000 pounds of waste. When combined with the previously identified waste streams such as scrap patties, cardboard, and retain samples, Taylorsville successfully diverted just over 200 tons of waste.

Rockport's Contribution

Rockport also made significant strides, diverting a new waste stream of 10,117 pounds of tapes generated during quality testing, just as the year concluded.

Looking Forward

Our waste reduction efforts demonstrate our ongoing commitment to sustainability. By continuously identifying and diverting waste streams, we're making significant strides towards our zero-waste goal, minimizing environmental impact, and creating more efficient operational practices.
