Description

NAV113 is a black post-consumer/post-industrial polyethylene recyclate (rPE) supplied in pellet form for pipe applications. NAV113 is an ideal PE used where sustainability and circularity matter. The post-consumer recyclate includes post-consumer waste coming from pre-sorted municpal household waste, the post-industrial recyclate consists of post-industrial waste from Borealis plants. Due to the nature of recyclates, some variation in colour between batches can be observed.

Processing techniques

NAV113 is easily processed on conventional extruders. Following extrusion parameters should be used as guideline:

Processing setting	Typical value/range
Melt temperature	160 - 190 °C

Due to differences in screw and die head designs the optimum temperature adjustments are individual and should be evaluated for each production line.

Packaging and storage

NAV113 should be stored in dry conditions at temperatures below 50°C and protected from UV-light. Improper storage can initiate degradation, which can result in odour generation and colour changes and can have negative effects on the physical properties of this product.
