It is a part of EuCertPlast certificate according to European Standard EN15343:2007 (certificate available upon request). Due to the nature of recyclates, some variation in colour can be observed between batches.

Processing techniques

This product is easy to process with standard injection moulding machines. Following parameters should be used as guideline:

Holding pressure ³	350 bar
Mould temperature ⁴	35 °C

Injection speed: High

Shrinkage 1 - 2%, depending on wall thickness and moulding parameters

Packaging and storage

Purpolen™ PP-89 should be stored in dry conditions at temperatures below 50°C and protected from UV-light. Improper storage can initiate degradation, which can result in odour generation and colour changes and can have negative effects on the physical properties of this product.
