



Eye protection

Remember to protect your eyes and always choose the right protectors for each work task! There are different types of protectors: safety glasses, mask-



shaped eye protectors, and face-shaped protectors such as a visor, welding mask and hooded protector. Eye protectors must fit as tightly

as possible on the face so that they also protect against sparks, splashes, fragments or flying objects coming from above, from the side and below. The eye protection must therefore fit the shape of the face and it is good to make sure that they do not restrict the field of vision. All types of protectors must have the CE mark and the standard abbreviation EN 166.

Eye injuries are usually serious and in the worst case they can permanently damage the sense of sight. In most cases, eye injuries require medical attention.
