



Before you start any job always think first what you are going to do and what risks it involves. Think step by step how I should do the work task and remember to observe the work site and its surroundings. It is important to consider what else is happening in the area on the same day. Before starting work, make sure that the safety measures are sufficient.

During the work, it is necessary to stay alert and observe possible changes, unforeseen problems and new risks. If these occur, stop and repeat the Take 2 steps. If you have doubts about whether the Take 2 steps should be repeated, ask yourself, do you feel safe and

is everyone around you working safely?

After the work task, it is important to check the safety of the work site and its surroundings. If there are some new risks from the work, take action to control any hazards that may have been created. It is also good to consider how the work went? Could I do the task even safer in the future? Don't forget to share your reflections and learnings with others.

If we don't do it safely, we don't do it at all!
