Scope

This document defines and clarifies Borealis' position with regards to our obligations under the Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR) based on our supplier role in the packaging supply chain.

Requirements for substances in packaging

Heavy metals

The sum of lead, cadmium, mercury and hexavalent chromium does not exceed 100 ppm in any of the **Borealis' products intended for packaging applications**. This is verified by compositional information of raw materials for virgin materials, and regular testing for mechanically recycled materials. For product specific confirmation, please refer to "Statement on Chemicals, Regulations and Standards".

PFAS

PFAS (per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances) are not intentionally used as raw materials, additives, or processing aids in any of **Borealis' product formulations intended for food-contact packaging applications**. Based on our knowledge of raw material composition, supplier declarations, and strict formulation controls, any PFAS potentially present as an unintended trace impurity in these pellets remains below 50 ppm of total fluorine as defined in Article 5(5) of the PPWR. For product specific confirmation, please refer to "Statement on Chemicals, Regulations and Standards".

Substances of Concern

We confirm that we do not use or intentionally incorporate any Substances of Concern (SoC) meeting the criteria described in point 27a-c of Article 2 "Definitions" in Chapter I (General Provisions) of the Ecodesign for Sustainable Products Regulation (EU) 2024/1781, in amounts that exceed currently applicable classification or regulatory limits in any of the Borealis' products intended for packaging applications. At this point in time it is not possible to state anything on point 27d of that same Article as the list of chemicals meeting this SoC criterion has not yet been defined.
