On 17 November and 29 December 2023 new chemicals have been added to the list of chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer for purposes of Proposition 65. These chemicals are not used or intentionally added during manufacturing of our polyolefin products and therefore not expected to be present. However, the products have not been specifically analysed for the presence of these substances.

- Fluoro-edenite fibrous amphibole
- Silicon carbide whiskers
